Restoration of All Things*

Genesis 1:1-6;2; Isaiah 42:5-43:10; John 1:1-17*

**\*Genesis 1:1** In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

**\*Genesis 1:1** says **In the beginning...**

**\*Exodus 3:13-14** Then Moses asked God, Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, The God of your fathers has sent me to you, and they ask me, What is His name? What should I tell them? God said to Moses, I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: I AM has sent Me to you.

**\*Psalm 39:4** O Lord, make me know my end and what is the measure of my days; let me know how fleeting I am!

**\*Psalm 90:12** So teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom.

**\*Revelation 1:8** I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, says the Lord, who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.

**\*Genesis 2:7** And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.

**\*II Thessalonians 1:7-10...** and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Yeshua Ha Messiah. These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, when He comes, in that Day, to be glorified in His saints and to be admired among all those who believe, because our testimony among you was believed.

**\*Mark 9:45-46** And if your foot causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter life lame than with two feet to be thrown into hell. And if your eye causes you to sin, tear it out. It is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into hell, where their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched.

**\*Matthew 25:41&46** Then he will say to those on his left, Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. . . . And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.

**\*Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in the Messiah Yeshua, our Lord.

**\*I Timothy 1:16** But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Messiah Yeshua might display His immense patience as an example for those who would believe in him and receive eternal life.

**\*Genesis 2:7** And the LORD God formed man from the dust of the ground and breathed נִשְׁמַת into his nostrils the breath of life and the man became לְבַיִשׁ a living being.

**\*Genesis 1:2-3** The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the **Spirit of God** was hovering over the face of the waters. Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

**\*1 John 1:5** This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

**\*Genesis 1:26-27** Then God said, Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth. So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

**\*Matthew 5:14-16** You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet. You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

**\*John 1:14** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

**\*John 1:2-4** He was with God in the beginning. Through Him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. In Him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind.

**\*Malachi 2:6** The law of truth was in his mouth and nothing false was found on his lips. He walked with Me in peace and uprightness, and turned many from sin.

**\*Malachi 2:7** For the lips of a priest should keep knowledge, and people should seek the law from his mouth; for he is the messenger of the LORD of Hosts.

**\*Revelation 1:1** The Revelation of Yeshua Messiah, which God gave Him to show His servants—

**\*Revelation 1:20** The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches.

**\*Revelation 1:6** and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

**\*John 14:6:** Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

**\*John 4:24** God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.

**\*Genesis 3:8** And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

**\*Genesis 3:1-7** Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, Has God indeed said, You shall not eat of every tree of the garden? And the woman said to the serpent, We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die. Then the serpent said to the woman, You will not surely die. For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil. So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate. Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings.

**\*Genesis 3:12-13** Then the man said, The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate. And the Lord God said to the woman, What is this you have done? The woman said, The serpent deceived me, and I ate.

**\*Genesis 4:2-8** Then she bore again, this time his brother Abel. Now Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground. And in the process of time, it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to the Lord. Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat. And the Lord respected Abel and his offering, but He did not respect Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell. So the Lord said to Cain, Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen? If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire is for you, but you should rule over it. Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.

**\*Genesis 4:23-24** Then Lamech said to his wives, Adah and Zillah, hear my voice; Wives of Lamech, listen to my speech! For I have killed a man for wounding me, even a young man for hurting me. If Cain shall be avenged sevenfold, then Lamech seventy-sevenfold.

**\*Matthew 18:21-22** Then Peter came to Yeshua and asked, Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? Up to seven times? Yeshua answered, I tell you, not seven times, but seventy times seven.
