*The "Heel" and the End of Days!!*  
*November 30, 2024; Chesvan 29, 5785*  
*Genesis 25:19-28:9; 1 Samuel 20:18-42; Matthew 24:29-36*

\* **Genesis 25:19** This is the genealogy **תולדת** of Isaac, Abraham's son. Abraham begot Isaac. Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah as wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padan Aram, the sister of Laban the Syrian.

\* **Genesis 2:4** These are the generations **תולדות** of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens.

\* **Ruth 4:18** Now these are the generations **תולדות** of **Perez**: Perez begat Hezron, Hezron begot Ram, and Ram begot Amminadab; Amminadab begot Nahshon, and Nahshon begot Salmon; Salmon begot Boaz, and Boaz begot Obed; Obed begot Jesse, and Jesse begot **David**.

\* **Matthew 11:1-12** Now it came to pass, when Yeshua finished commanding His twelve disciples, that He departed from there to teach and to preach in their cities. And when John had heard in prison about the works of Messiah, he sent two of his disciples and said to Him, Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another? Jesus answered and said to them, **Go and tell John the things which you hear and see: The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them.**

And blessed is he who is **not** because of Me. As they departed, Yeshua began to say to the multitudes concerning John: "What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken by the wind? But what did you go out to see? A man clothed in soft garments? Indeed, those who wear soft clothing are in kings' houses. But what did you go out to see? A prophet? Yes, I say to you, and more than a prophet. For this is he of whom it is written: Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, who will prepare Your way before You. Assuredly, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist; but **he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and (NOW) the violent take it by force.**

\* **Matthew 11:12** (New Living) And from the time John the Baptist began preaching until now, **the Kingdom of Heaven has been forcefully advancing**, and violent people are attacking it.

**\*Matthew 11:12 (The Newer New Testament) From the days of Yochanan the Immerser until now, the kingdom of heaven is powerfully breaking its way forward, and people breaking out with its power are seizing hold of it.**

**\*Micah 2:12-13** I will surely gather all of you, O Jacob I will collect the remnant of Israel. I will bring them together like sheep in a pen, like a flock in the midst of its pasture - a noisy throng. One who breaks open the way will go up before them; they will break through the gate, and go out by it. Their King will pass through before them, the LORD as their leader....

**\*Genesis 25:21-23** Now Isaac pleaded with the LORD for his wife, because she was barren; and the Lord granted his plea, and Rebekah his wife conceived. But the children struggled together within her; and she said, "If all is well, why am I like this?" So she went to inquire of the LORD. And the LORD said to her: "Two nations are in your womb, Two peoples shall be separated from your body; One people shall be stronger than the other, And the older shall serve the younger.

**\*Genesis 25:24-25** So when her days were fulfilled for her to give birth, indeed there were twins in her womb. And the first came out red. He was like a hairy garment all over; so they called his name Esau.

**\*I Samuel 16:12** So he sent and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, with bright eyes, and good-looking. And the LORD said, "Arise, anoint him; for this is the one!"

**\*Genesis 25:26** Afterward his brother came out, and his hand took hold of Esau's heel; so his name was called Jacob. Isaac was sixty years old when she bore them.

**\*Genesis 2:15** And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel.

**\*Isaiah 52:13** Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently; He shall be exalted and extolled and be very high.

**\*Isaiah 41:8** But you, Israel, are My servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, The descendants of Abraham My friend.

**\*Genesis 25:27-28** So the boys grew. And Esau was a skillful hunter, a man of the field; but Jacob was a mild man, dwelling in tents. And Isaac loved Esau because he ate of his game, but Rebekah loved Jacob.

**\*Genesis 25:29-34** Now Jacob cooked a stew; and Esau came in from the field, and he was weary. And Esau said to Jacob, Please feed me with that same **red stew**, for I am weary. **Therefore his name was called Edom.** But Jacob said, Sell me your birthright as of this day. And Esau said, Look, **I am about to die; so what is this birthright to me?** Then Jacob said, Swear to me as of this day. So he swore to him, and **sold his birthright to Jacob.** And Jacob gave Esau bread and stew of lentils; then he ate and drank, arose, and **went his way.** Thus **Esau despised his birthright.**

**\*Genesis 27:1-5** Now it came to pass, when Isaac was old and his eyes were so dim that he could not see, that he called Esau his older son and said to him, My son. And he answered him, Here I am. Then he said, Behold now, I am old. I do not know the day of my death. Now therefore, please take your weapons, your quiver and your bow, and go out to the field and hunt game for me. And make me savory food, such as I love, and bring it to me that I may eat, that **my soul may bless you before I die.** Now **Rebekah was listening when Isaac spoke to Esau his son.** And Esau went to the field to hunt game and to bring it.

**\*Genesis 27:21-26** So Jacob went near to Isaac his father, and he felt him and said, The **voice is Jacob's voice,** but the **hands are the hands of Esau.**" And he did not recognize him, because his hands were hairy like his brother Esau's hands; **so he blessed him.** Then he said, Are you really my son Esau?" He said, I am. He said, Bring it near to me, and I will eat of my son's game, so that my soul may bless you. So he brought it near to him, and he ate; and he brought him wine, and he drank. Then his father Isaac said to him, "Come near now and kiss me, my son.

**\*Genesis 27:27** And he came near and kissed him; and he **smelled the smell of his clothing,** and blessed him and said: "Surely, **the smell of my son** is like the smell of a field Which the Lord has blessed.

**\*Psalm 45:6-8** Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. You love righteousness and hate wickedness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the **oil of gladness** more than Your companions. **All Your garments are scented with myrrh and aloes and cassia,**

**\*Psalm 45:13-15** The royal daughter is all glorious within the palace; Her clothing is woven with gold. She shall be brought to the King in robes of many colors; The virgins, (THINK OF THE 10 VIRGINS) her companions who follow her, shall be brought to You. With **gladness and rejoicing they shall be brought;** They shall enter the King's palace.

**\*Song of Songs 1:13** **A bundle of myrrh** is my beloved to me, that lies all night between my breasts. And again:

**\*Song of Songs 5:13** His lips are lilies, **dripping liquid myrrh.**

**\*Song of Songs 5:5** I arose to open for my beloved, and my hands dripped with myrrh, my fingers with liquid myrrh, on the handles of the lock.

**2 Corinthians 2:14-15** But thanks be to God, who always leads us triumphantly as captives in Messiah and through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of Him. For we are to God the sweet aroma of Messiah among those who are being saved and those who are perishing. To the one we are an odor of death and demise; to the other, a fragrance that brings life.

**\*Ephesians 5:2** and walk in love, just as Messiah loved us and gave Himself up for us as a fragrant sacrificial offering to God.

**\*Genesis 27:27b-29** "Surely, the smell of my son is like the smell of a field which the LORD has blessed. Therefore, may God give you of the dew of heaven, of the fatness of the earth, and plenty of grain and wine. Let peoples serve you, and nations bow down to you. Be master over your brethren, and let your mother's sons bow down to you. Cursed be everyone who curses you, and blessed be those who bless you!

**\*Genesis 27:35-36** But he said, Your brother came with deceit and has taken away your blessing. And Esau said, "Is he not rightly named Jacob? For he has supplanted me these two times. He took away my birthright, and now look, he has taken away my blessing! And he said, Have you not reserved a blessing for me?"

**\*Genesis 27:41** So Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing with which his father blessed him, and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then I will kill my brother Jacob.

**\*Mathew 24:29-36** "Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the **powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven,** and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and **they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven.**

**\*Daniel 7:13-14** In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed.

....Matt. 27: cont. Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven

with power and great glory. <sup>31</sup> And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet,

\***I Corinthians 15:52** in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. and they (will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

**Matthew 27 cont.** <sup>32</sup> "Now learn this parable from the fig tree:

\***Hosea 9:10** I found Israel like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers As the firstfruits on the fig tree in its first season.

\***Jeremiah 8:13** I will surely consume them, says the Lord. No grapes shall be on the vine, Nor figs on the fig tree, And the leaf shall fade; And the things I have given them shall pass away from them.

\***Matthew 27 cont.** When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. When you see all these things, know that it is near--at the doors! <sup>34</sup> Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place. <sup>35</sup> Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away. But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only.

\***Isaiah 35:10** So the redeemed of the LORD will return and enter Zion with singing, crowned with everlasting joy. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee.
