The Trigger Point for Gog And Magog
January 25, 2025; Tevet 25, 5785
Exodus 6:2-9:35; Ezekiel 28:25-29:21; Luke 11:14-22

***Exodus 4:19-23** The LORD said to Moshe in Midyan, "Go on back to Egypt, because all the men who wanted to kill you are dead." So Moshe took his wife and sons, put them on a donkey, and started out for Egypt. Moshe took God's staff in his hand. The LORD said to Moshe, "When you get back to Egypt, make sure that you do before Pharaoh every one of the wonders I have enabled you to do.

***John 14:11** Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me—or at least believe on account of the works themselves.

***John 5:19** So Jesus replied, Truly, truly, I tell you, the Son can do nothing by Himself, unless He sees the Father doing it. For whatever the Father does, the Son also does.

***John 14:12a** Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do:.

***John 14:12b** and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.

***John 14:13** And I will do whatever you ask in My name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son....

***Exodus 4:21-23** Nevertheless, **I am going to make him hardhearted, and he will refuse to let the people go.** Then you are to tell Pharaoh: 'The LORD says, Isra'el is my firstborn son. I have told you to let my son go in order to worship me, but you have refused to let him go. Well, then, I will kill your firstborn son!

***Exodus 5:2** Pharaoh said, Who is HASHEM that I should listen to His voice to send out Israel? I do not know HASHEM, and furthermore, Israel I will not send out!

***Exodus 5:22-23** Moshe returned to *Adonai* and said, *Adonai*, why have you treated this people so terribly? What has been the value of sending me? For ever since I came to Pharaoh to speak in your name, he has dealt terribly with this people! And you haven't rescued your people at all!

***Exodus 6:2** God spoke to Moshe; he said to him, I am Adonai Yud-Heh-Vav-Heh. I appeared to Avraham, Yitz'chak and Ya'akov as El Shaddai, although I did not make myself known to them by my name, Yud-Heh-Vav-Heh [Adonai].

***Exodus 6:6a** Therefore say to the children of Israel: I am the LORD;

***Philippians 2:7-9** On the contrary, He emptied himself, in that He took the form of a slave by becoming like human beings are. And when He appeared as a human being, He humbled himself still more by becoming obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Therefore, God raised Him to the highest place and gave Him the name above every name;

***Lamentations 3:21-24** But in my mind I keep returning to something, something that gives me hope - that the grace of ADONAI - יהוה (is not exhausted, that his compassion has not ended. [On the contrary,] they are new every morning! How great your faithfulness! "ADONAI - יהוה is all I have, therefore, I say; I will put my hope in him.

***Matthew 5:7** How blessed are those who show mercy! for they will be shown mercy.

***Isaiah 25:1** Israel, the Lord who created you says Do not be afraid—I will save you. I have called you by name—you are mine.

Jeremiah 30:1-7 This is the word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD: This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: 'Write in a book all the words I have spoken to you. The days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will bring my people Israel and Judah back from captivity and restore them to the land I gave their ancestors to possess,' says the LORD.

These are the words the LORD spoke concerning Israel and Judah: This is what the LORD says:

Cries of fear are heard—terror, not peace. Ask and see:

Can a man bear children? Then why do I see every strong man with his hands on his stomach like a woman in labor, every face turned deathly pale? How awful that day will be! No other will be like it. It will be a time of trouble for Jacob, **but he will be saved out of it**.

***Exodus 6:5** Moreover, I have heard the groaning of the people of Isra'el, whom the Egyptians are keeping in slavery; and I have remembered my covenant.

***Exodus 6:6b** I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.

***Ezekiel 34:13** And I will bring them out מן הַמְּצָרִים from the peoples and gather them from the countries, and will bring them into their own land.

***Exodus 6:6** Therefore, say to the people of Isra'el: I am ADONAI (יהוה) and I will bring you out מִן הַמְּצָרִים from the forced labor of the Egyptians, and I will rescue you וְהִצַּלְתִּי from their bondage and I will redeem וְגָאַלְתִּי you with an outstretched arm.

***Psalms 144:7:** Stretch out your hand from above, rescue me, and deliver me out of great waters, out of the hands of foreigners.

***Deuteronomy 32:36:** The LORD (YUD HEY VAV HEY) will rescue his people when he sees that their strength is gone.

***Psalm 18:17:** He (LORD YUD HEY VAV HEY) rescued me from my strong enemy and from those who hated me, for they were too mighty for me.

***2 Peter 2:9:** The Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials and to hold the unrighteous for punishment on the day of judgment.

***Isaiah 11:1** root **1** But a branch will emerge אֶצְטָא from the trunk of Yishai (Jesse), a shoot will grow from His roots. מִשְׁרָשׁוּי

***Luke 3:31b-32a** ...the son of Nathan, the son of David the son of Jessi.....

***Luke 19:41-43** Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it, saying, If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation.

***Romans 5:8** But God proves His love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

***Genesis 44:32-33** For your servant became surety for the lad to my father, saying, If I do not bring him back to you, then I shall bear the blame in the sight of my father all my life. Now therefore, let your servant, I pray you, remain instead of the lad as a slave to my lord; and let the lad go back with his brothers.

***Genesis 45:1-3a** Then **Joseph** could not control himself before all those who stood by him; and he cried, Make every one go out from me. So no one stayed with him when Joseph made himself known to his brothers. And he wept aloud, so that the Egyptians heard it, and the household of Pharaoh heard it. And Joseph said to his brothers, I am Joseph; is my father still alive?

***Galatians 6:2** Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Messiah.

***Isaiah 37:31** And the remnant who have escaped of the house of Judah shall again take root downward, and bear fruit upward.

***Matthew 6:19-20** Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal...

***John 15:13** Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

***Ezekiel 38:15-16** You will choose just that time to come from your place in the far reaches of the north, you and many peoples with you, all of them on horseback, a huge horde, a mighty army; and you will invade my people Isra'el like a cloud covering the land. This will be in the acharit-hayamim; and I will bring you against My land, so that the Goyim will know Me when, before their eyes, I am set apart as holy through you, Gog. Adonai Eloheim says: 'I spoke of you long ago through My servants the prophets of Isra'el. Back then, they prophesied for many years that I would have you invade them.

***Ezekiel 38:20** ...and all men who are on the face of the earth shall shake at My presence.....21) I will call for a sword against Gog through all My mountains says the Lord God.....22a I will bring him to judgement....23 Thus I will magnify Myself and sanctify Myself, and I will be known in the eyes of many nations. Then they shall know that I am the Lord....39:1 I am against you O, Gog.....39:2 I will turn you around and lead you on39:3 I will knock the bow out of your left hand and cause the arrows to fall out of your right hand....I will give you to birds of prey.....
