



Congregation Notes VaYikra
Prophecy in the Offerings
Leviticus 1:1-5:26 (6:7); Isaiah 43:2; Matthew 5:23-30
April 5, 2025; Nisan 7, 5785

***Exodus 40:34-35** Then the cloud covered the tabernacle of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. And Moses was not able to enter the tabernacle of meeting, because the cloud rested above it, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.

***Exodus 40:38** For the cloud of the LORD was above the tabernacle by day, and fire was over it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.

***Deuteronomy 31:6** Be strong and courageous. Do not fear or be in dread of them, for it is the LORD your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you.

***Matthew 28:20** Teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

***Revelation 5:10** ...and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth.

***Leviticus 1:1** And He called Moses and spoke HaShem spoke to him from the Tent of Meeting, saying:

***Numbers 12:3** Now Moses was a very humble man, more so than any man on the face of the earth.

***Numbers 23:4** And God (Eloheim) met with Balaam and he said to Him, seven altars I have prepared and I have offered a bull and a ram on each altar.

***Joshua 13:22** Balaam also, the son of Beor, the one who practiced divination, was killed with the sword by the people of Israel among the rest of their slain.

***2 Peter 2:15** Forsaking the right way, they have gone astray. They have followed the way of Balaam, the son of Beor, who loved gain from wrongdoing,

***Revelation 2:14** But I have a few things against you: you have some there who hold the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the sons of Israel, so that they might eat food sacrificed to idols and practice sexual immorality.

***Jeremiah 23:16** Thus says the Lord of hosts: "Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you. They make you worthless; They speak a vision of their own heart, Not from the mouth of the Lord. They continually say to those who despise Me, 'The Lord has said, "You shall have peace"'; And to everyone who walks according to the dictates of his own heart, they say, 'No evil shall come upon you.'

***Deuteronomy 18:10-12** There shall not be found among you anyone who burns his son or his daughter as an offering, anyone who practices divination or tells fortunes or interprets omens, or a sorcerer.

***Isaiah 41:10** Even when life throws you the greatest challenges, be reminded: Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

***I Peter 3:1-4** Likewise, wives, be subject to your own husbands, so that even if some do not obey the word, they may be won without a word by the conduct of their wives, when they see your respectful and pure conduct. Do not let your adorning be external—the braiding of hair and the putting on of gold jewelry, or the clothing you wear— but let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious.

***I Peter 1:7** So that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Yeshua Messiah.

***Leviticus 1:1** And He called to Moses, and HaShem (Yud Hey Vav Hey) spoke to him from the Tent of Meeting saying:

***Deuteronomy 5:22** If we hear the voice of G-d . . . any more, we shall die,...

***Leviticus 1:1-2** And He called to Moses; and G-d spoke to him out of the Tent of Meeting, saying: Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: A man who shall bring near of you an offering to G-d, of the cattle, of the herd and of the flock shall you bring near your offering . . .

***Leviticus 1:2** Speak to the Children of Israel and you should say to them: a man when he brings from among you an offering to HaShem from the animals from the cattle and from the flock shall you bring your offering.

***Psalm 73:23-26** Nevertheless, I am continually with you; you hold my right hand. You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will receive me to glory. Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

***Romans 12:1** I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

***Hebrews 13:15-16** Through him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name. Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.

***Ephesians 5:1-2** Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Messiah loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

***Leviticus 1:3** If a burnt offering is one's offering, he shall offer an unblemished male; bring it to the entrance of the Tent of Meeting he shall bring it, willingly before HaShem.

***Exodus 12:5** Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats.

***John 1:29** The next day John saw Yeshua coming toward him and said, Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

***Leviticus 1:4** He shall support his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to atone for him.

***I Peter 1:18-19** For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, but with the precious blood of Messiah, a lamb without blemish or defect.

***Leviticus 1:3** If his offering is a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish; he shall offer it of his own free will at the door of the tabernacle of meeting before the LORD.

***Leviticus 1:5** He shall kill the bull before the Lord; and the priests, Aaron's sons, shall bring the blood and sprinkle the blood all around on the altar that is by the door of the tabernacle of meeting.

***Hebrews 9:13-15** For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who are ceremonially unclean sanctify them so that their bodies are clean, how much more will the blood of Messiah, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself

unblemished to God, purify our consciences from works of death, so that we may serve the living God! Therefore, Messiah is the mediator of a new covenant, so that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance, now that He has died to redeem them from the transgressions committed under the first covenant....

***Leviticus 8:12** And he poured of the anointing הַמִּשְׁחָה oil upon Aaron's head, and he anointed וַיִּמְשַׁח him, to sanctify him.

***2 Corinthians 2:15** For we are the aroma of Messiah to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing,

***Genesis 15:5-6** And the LORD took him outside and said, Now look to the heavens and count the stars, if you are able. Then He told him, So shall your offspring be.....And he believed in the LORD, and He accounted it to him for righteousness.
