Is There A Mitzvah That Will Bri the Messiah?

Deut. 26:1-29:9; Isa. 60:1-22; Matthew 4:13-14

***Deuteronomy 21:10** When you will go out to the war against your enemies, HaShem, your God, will deliver him into your h and, and you will capture captives from it.....

***Deuteronomy 26:1-2** And it shall be, when you come into the land which the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance, and you possess it and dwell in it,² that you shall take some of the first of all the produce of the ground, which you shall bring from your land that the Lord your God is giving you, and put it in a basket and go to the place where the Lord your God chooses to make His name abide.

***Exodus 23:19** The first of the firstfruits of your land you shall bring into the house of the LORD your God. You shall not boil a young goat in its mother's milk.

***Hebrews 10:24-25** And let us consider how to spur one another on to love and good deeds; not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

***Malachi 3:10** "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house."

***Mark 11:15-18** So they came to Jerusalem. Then Yeshua went into the temple and began to drive out those who bought and sold in the temple and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves.¹⁶ And He would not allow anyone to carry wares through the temple.¹⁷ Then He taught, saying to them, "Is it not written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations'? But you have made it a 'den of thieves.'"

¹⁸ And the scribes and chief priests heard it and sought how they might destroy Him; for they feared Him, because all the people were astonished at His teaching.

***I Timothy 6:9-11** Those who want to be rich, however, fall into temptation and become ensnared by many foolish and harmful desires that plunge them into ruin and destruction.

For the love of money is the root of all kinds of evil. By craving it, some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many sorrows. But you, O man of God, flee from these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance, and gentleness....

***Deuteronomy 26:11-12** When you have finished paying all the tithe of your produce the third year, [which is] the year of tithing, then you shall give it to the Levite, to the stranger, to the orphan, and to the widow, so that they may eat within the gates of your cities and be satisfied.

***Genesis 22:2** Take your son, God said, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah. Offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains, which I will show you.

***Genesis 6:22** Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great upon the earth, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was altogether evil all the time.

***John 19:39-40** Nicodemus, who had previously come to Yeshua at night, also brought a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about seventy-five pounds. / So they took the body of Yeshua and wrapped it in linen cloths with the spices, according to the Jewish burial custom.

***Matthew 16:24** 24 Then Yeshua said to His disciples, If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.

***John 15:13** Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

***Genesis 22:1-4** Now it came to pass after these things that God tested Abraham, and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." ² Then He said, "Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you."

³ So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son; and he split the wood for the burnt offering, and arose

and went to the place of which God had told him. ⁴ Then on the third day Abraham
lifted his eyes and saw the place מִקְוֶה afar off.

***Romans 11:16** Now if the firstfruit is holy, so is the whole loaf. And if the root is holy, so are the branches.

***I Corinthians 15:23-24** But each one in his own order: Messiah the firstfruits, afterward those who are Messiah's at His coming. ²⁴ Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. For He must reign till he has put all enemies under His feet.

***Deuteronomy 26:8** Then the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm, with great terror, signs, and wonders. 9 And He brought us to this place and gave us this land, a land flowing with mild and honey.

10 And now, behold, I have brought the firstfruits of the land that You, O LORD, have given me." Then you are to place the basket before the LORD your God and bow down before Him....

***Deuteronomy 26:13a** Then you shall declare in the presence of the LORD your God, "I have removed from my house the sacred portion and have given it to the Levite, the foreigner, the fatherless, and the widow, according to all the commandments You have given me. I have not transgressed or forgotten Your commandments....

***Deuteronomy 26:15** Look down from Your holy habitation, from heaven, and bless Your people Israel and the land You have given us as You swore to our fathers—a land flowing with milk and honey.

***Ephesians 5:25-27** Husbands, love your wives, just as Messiah loved the church and gave Himself up for her **26 to sanctify her, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word -**

***Philippians 2:10-11** that at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, ¹¹ and that every tongue should confess that Yeshua Messiah is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
