Deceiving Spirits; Doctrines of Demons and Today!

Sept. 27, 2025; Tishrei 5,5786

Deut. 31:1-30; Hosea 14:2-10; Mic. 7:18-20; Matt. 18:21-35

***Deuteronomy 31:1-3** Then Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel. 2And he said to them: "I am one hundred and twenty years old today. I can no longer go out and come in. for the LORD has said to me, "You shall not cross over this Jordan.

***Deuteronomy 34:7** Moses was 120 years old when he died, yet his **eyesight was still good**, and his **body was strong**.

***I Corinthians 10:4** They all ate the same spiritual food and drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Messiah.

***Numbers 20:2,3a** Now there was no water for the congregation; so they gathered together against Moses and Aaron. ³And the people contended with Moses and spoke, saying: If only we had died when our brethren died before the Lord!

***Numbers 20:7-8a** Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, ⁸**Take the rod**; you and your brother Aaron gather the congregation together. **Speak** to the rock before their eyes, and it will yield its water;

***Numbers 20:10-12** And Moses and Aaron gathered the assembly together **before the rock**; and he said to them, "Hear now, you rebels! Must we bring water for you out of this rock?" ¹¹Then **Moses lifted his hand and struck the rock twice with his rod**; and water came out abundantly, and the congregation and their animals drank. ¹²Then the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, Because **you did not believe Me, to hallow Me in the eyes of the children of Israel**, therefore **you shall not bring this assembly into the land which I have given them**.

I Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, **giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons**, ²**speaking lies** in hypocrisy, having their **own conscience seared** with a hot iron,

***Colossians 3:1-3** If then you have been raised with Messiah, seek the things that are above, where Messiah is, seated at the right hand of God. **Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth**. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Messiah in God. **When Messiah who is your life appears**, then you also will appear with him in glory. **Put to death therefore what is earthly in you**: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.

***Joel 2:12-13** Yet even now, declares the Lord, return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning; and rend your hearts and not your garments. Return to the LORD your God,

for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love; and he relents over disaster.

***2 Peter 2:3-4** Many will follow in their depravity, and because of them the way of truth will be defamed. In their greed, these false teachers will exploit you with deceptive words, the longstanding verdict against them remains in force, and their destruction does not sleep. **4**For if God did not spare the angels when they sinned, but cast them deep into hell, placing them in chains of darkness to be held for judgment;...

***Exodus 14:16** But lift up your rod, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it. And the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.

***Exodus 14:19-22** And the Angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them; and the pillar of cloud went from before them and stood behind them. ²⁰So it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel. Thus it was a cloud and darkness to the one, and it gave light by night to the other, so that the one did not come near the other all that night.

²¹Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea into dry land, and the waters were divided. ²²So the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea on the dry ground, and the waters were a wall to them on their right hand and on their left.

***Deuteronomy 31:3a** The LORD your God Himself crosses over before you; He will destroy these nations from before you, and you shall dispossess them. Joshua himself crosses over before you, just as the LORD has said.

***John 12:23-25** But Yeshua replied, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. ²⁴Truly, truly, I tell you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a seed; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.

25Whoever loves his life will lose it, but whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life....

***Genesis 49:18** I have waited for your salvation, O LORD!

***Exodus 14:13** And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever.

***Psalm 119:155** Salvation is far from the wicked, for they do not seek Your statutes.

***Deuteronomy 31:3** The LORD your God Himself crosses over before you; He will destroy these nations from before you, and you shall dispossess them. Joshua himself crosses over before you, just as the Lord has said.

***Hebrews 4:1-5** Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it. **2**For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it. **3**For we who have believed do enter that rest, as He has said:

“So I swore in My wrath,
‘They shall not enter My rest,’ ”

although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

***James 2:17** Faith without works is dead.

***Deuteronomy 31:15-18** Now the LORD appeared at the tabernacle in a pillar of cloud, and the pillar of cloud stood above the door of the tabernacle.

¹⁶ And the LORD said to Moses: “Behold, you will rest with your fathers; and this people will rise and play the harlot with the gods of the foreigners of the land, where they go to be among them, and they will forsake Me and break My covenant which I have made with them. ¹⁷ Then My anger shall be aroused against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide My face from them, and they shall be devoured. And many evils and troubles shall befall them, so that they will say in that day, ‘Have not these evils come upon us because our God is not among us?’ ¹⁸ And I will surely hide My face in that day because of all the evil which they have done, in that they have turned to other gods.

***Deuteronomy 31:19-21** Now therefore, write down this song for yourselves, and teach it to the children of Israel; put it in their mouths, that this song may be a witness for Me against the children of Israel. ²⁰ When I have brought them to the land flowing with milk and honey, of which I swore to their fathers, and they have eaten and filled themselves and grown fat, then they will turn to other gods and serve them; and they will provoke Me and break My covenant. ²¹ Then it shall be, when many evils and troubles have come upon them, that this song will testify against them as a witness; for it will not be forgotten in the mouths of their descendants, for I know the inclination of their behavior today, even before I have brought them to the land of which I swore to give them.
