The Hatching of the Viper's Egg Brings Satan  
Oct. 4, 2025; Tishrei 12, 5786  
Deut. 32:1-52; ii Sam. 22:1-51; Jn. 6:26-35

**\*Exodus 6:6-8** Therefore, say to the children of Israel: 'I am the Lord; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. <sup>7</sup> I will take you as My people, and I will be your God. Then you shall know that I am the Lord your God who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. <sup>8</sup> And I will bring you into the land which I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; and I will give it to you as a heritage: I am the Lord.

**\*Micah 7:15-16** As in the days when you came out of Egypt, I will show My wonders. <sup>16</sup> Nations will see and be ashamed, deprived of all their might. They will put their hands over their mouths, and their ears will become deaf....

**\*Deuteronomy 32:1** Give ear, O ye heavens, and I will speak; and hear, O earth, the words of my mouth. Let my teaching drop as the rain, My speech distill as the dew, As raindrops on the tender herb, And as showers on the grass.

**\*John 6:33** For the bread of God is He who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.

**\*Proverbs 4:20-22** My son, give attention to my words, incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes, Keep them in the midst of your heart; For they are life to those who find them and health **to all their flesh.**

**\*Zephaniah 3:4** Her prophets are insolent, treacherous people; her priests have polluted the sanctuary, they have done violence to the law.

**\*Deuteronomy 32:3,4a,10-14 (selected)** For I proclaim the name of the LORD; ascribe greatness to our God. He is the Rock, His work is perfect, for all His ways are justice, a God of truth and without injustice.....He found him He encircled him, instructed him, He kept him as the apple of His eye He carried them on His wings, ....He made him ride in the heights of the earth,....He made him draw honey from the rock,.....And you drank wine, the blood of grapes. **But.....**

**\*Deuteronomy 32:15-20** "But Jeshurun grew fat and kicked; You grew fat, you grew thick, You are obese! Then **he forsook God who made him**, and scornfully esteemed the Rock of his salvation. <sup>16</sup> They provoked Him to jealousy with foreign gods; With abominations they provoked Him to anger. <sup>17</sup> They **sacrificed to demons**, not to God, to gods they did not know, to new gods,

new arrivals that your fathers did not fear. <sup>18</sup> Of the Rock who begot you, you are unmindful, and have **forgotten the God who fathered you.**

<sup>19</sup> **"And when the LORD saw it, He spurned them, because of the provocation of His sons and His daughters. <sup>20</sup> And He said: I will hide My face from them, I will see what their end will be, for they are a perverse generation, children in whom is no faith. <sup>21</sup> They have provoked Me to jealousy by what is not God; they have moved Me to anger by their foolish idols. But I will provoke them to jealousy by those who are not a nation; I will move them to anger by a foolish nation. <sup>22</sup> For a fire is kindled by my anger, And shall burn to the lowest hell; it shall consume the earth with her increase, And set on fire the foundations of the mountains. <sup>23</sup> I will heap disasters on them; I will spend My arrows on them. <sup>24</sup> They shall be wasted with hunger, devoured by pestilence and bitter destruction; I will also send against them the teeth of beasts, with the poison of serpents of the dust. <sup>25</sup> The sword shall destroy outside; There shall be terror within for the young man and virgin, The nursing child with the man of gray hairs.**

**\*Deuteronomy 32:25** The sword shall destroy outside; There shall be terror within for the young man and virgin, The nursing child with the man of gray hairs.

**\*Obadiah 1:10** For violence (*hamas*) against your brother Jacob [Israel], Shame shall cover you, and you shall be cut off forever.

**\*Deuteronomy 32:24** They shall be wasted with hunger, devoured by pestilence and bitter destruction; I will also send against them the teeth of beasts, with the poison of serpents of the dust.

**\*Revelation 6:8** So I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him. And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death, and by the beasts of the earth.

**\*Deuteronomy 32:24b** also send against them the teeth of beasts, with the poison of serpents of the dust.

**Genesis 32:5** I have oxen, donkeys, flocks, and male and female servants; and I have sent to tell **my lord**, that I may **find favor in your sight**.

**\*Joel 3:2b** There **I will enter into judgment against them** concerning My people, My inheritance, Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations **as they divided up My land**.

**\*Daniel 9:27** And **he will confirm a covenant with many for one week**, but in the middle of the week he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of the temple will come the abomination that causes desolation, until the decreed destruction is poured out upon him.

**\*Genesis 3:14** So the Lord God said **to the serpent**: Because you have done this, you are cursed more than all cattle, and more than every beast of the field; **On your belly you shall go, and you shall eat dust** all the days of your life.

**\*Isaiah 59:4-6** **No one calls for justice nor does any plead for truth** They trust in empty words and speak lies; **they conceive evil and bring forth iniquity**. <sup>5</sup> They hatch vipers' eggs and weave the

spider's web; he who eats of their eggs dies, and from that which is crushed **a viper breaks out.**

**6**Their **webs will not become garments,**

Nor will they cover themselves with their works; their works *are* works of iniquity, and the act of violence *is* in their hands.

**\*Isaiah 59:6** **Their webs will not become garments,**

**\*Matthew 22:11-13** But when the king came in to see the guests, he spotted a man who was not dressed in wedding clothes. **'Friend,' he asked, 'how did you get in here without wedding clothes?'** But the man was speechless. **13**Then the king told the servants, 'Tie him hand and foot, and throw him into the outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'...

**\*Isaiah 59:6** Their webs will not become garments, nor will they cover themselves with their works; their works are works of nothingness, trouble and idol worship and the act of hamas and deception is in their hands.

**\*2Timothy 4:3-4** Paul wrote, "For **the time. (KAIRO) will come** when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; and **they shall turn away from the truth,** and shall be turned unto fables.

**\*Isaiah 59:5** They **hatch the eggs of vipers** and weave a spider's web. Whoever eats their eggs will die; **crack one open, and a viper is hatched.** When the viper's egg is hatched it brings forth a viper.

**\*Matthew 24:4** Yeshua answered, See to it that **no one deceives you.**

**\*Isaiah 14:29** A political oracle against Philistia warns that "**from the root of the snake will spring up a viper,**" foretelling a subsequent ruler more dangerous than the one just overthrown.
