"The Woman The Leper and The End!"

April 18, 2026; Iyyar 1, 5786

Lev. 12:1-15:33; Isa. 66:1-24; Mk. 9:40-50

***Leviticus 13:2** "When a man has on the skin of his body a swelling, a scab, or a bright spot, and it becomes on the skin of his body like a leprous sore, then he shall be brought to Aaron the priest or to one of his sons the priests."

***Leviticus 13:46** All the days during which the plague shall be in him, he shall be impure; he is tamei. He shall dwelt alone; outside the camp shall his habitation be.

***Leviticus 14:1-4** Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ² "This shall be the law of the leper for the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought to the priest. ³ And the priest shall go out of the camp, and the priest shall examine him; and indeed, if the leprosy is healed in the leper, ⁴ then the priest shall command to take for him who is to be cleansed two living and clean birds, cedar wood, scarlet, and hyssop.

***Numbers 12:5-8** ⁵ Then the LORD came down in the pillar of cloud and stood in the door of the tabernacle, and called Aaron and Miriam. And they both went forward. ⁶ Then He said, "Hear now My words:
If there is a prophet among you,
I, the Lord, make Myself known to him in a vision;
I speak to him in a dream. ⁷ Not so with My servant Moses;
He is faithful in all My house. ⁸ I speak with him face to face,
Even plainly, and not in dark sayings; And he sees the form of the Lord. Why then were you not afraid To speak against My servant Moses?"

***Numbers 12:9-11 & 13-15** So the anger of the LORD was aroused against them, and He departed. ¹⁰ And when the cloud departed from above the tabernacle, suddenly Miriam became leprous, as white as snow. Then Aaron turned toward Miriam, and there she was, a leper. ¹¹ So Aaron said to Moses, "Oh, my lord! Please do not lay this sin on us, in which we have done foolishly and in which we have sinned. ¹³ So Moses cried out to the Lord, saying, "Please heal her, O God, I pray!" ¹⁴ Then the LORD said to Moses, "If her father had but spit in her face, would she not be shamed seven days? Let her be shut out of the camp seven days, and afterward she may be received again." ¹⁵ So Miriam was shut out of the camp seven days, and the people did not journey till Miriam was brought in again.

***Leviticus 12:1-2** Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, saying: If a woman has conceived, and borne a male child, then she shall be unclean seven days; as in the days of her customary impurity she shall be unclean.

***Genesis 37:9-11** Then Joseph had another dream and told it to his brothers. Look, he said, I had another dream, and this time the sun and moon and eleven stars were bowing down to me. He told his father and brothers, but his father rebuked him and said, What is this dream that you have had? Will your mother the ground before you? And his brothers were jealous of him, but his father kept in mind what he had said.

***Revelation 12:5-6** And the dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, ready to devour her child as soon as she gave birth. And she gave birth to a son, a male child, who will rule all the nations with an iron scepter. And her child was caught up to God and to His throne. And the woman fled into the wilderness, where God had prepared a place for her to be nourished for 1,260 days.

***Leviticus 12:3** And on the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

***Luke 2:21-22** On the eighth day, when it was time to circumcise the child, he was named Yeshua, the name the angel had given him before he was conceived. And when the time of purification according to the Law of Moses was complete, His parents brought Him to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord...

***Romans 9:4-5** (Complete Jewish Bible) the people of Isra'el! They were made God's children, the Sh'khinah has been with them, the covenants are theirs, also the giving of the Torah, the Temple service and the promises; the Patriarchs are theirs; and from them, as far as his physical descent is concerned, came the Messiah, who is over all. Praised be Adonai forever! Amen.

***Romans 9:23-26** What if He did this in order to make known the riches of his glory to those who are the objects of His mercy, whom He prepared in advance for glory - that is, to us, whom he called not only from among the Jews but also from among the Gentiles?

As indeed he says in Hoshea, "Those who were not my people I will call my people; her who was not loved I will call loved; and in the very place where they were told, 'You are not my people,' there they will be called sons of the living God!"

***Romans 11:11-26 (selections)** I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation has come to the Gentiles. Now if their fall is riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness! 17And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, 18Do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you. 25For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. 26And so all Israel will be saved,

***Ephesians 2:11-22 (selections)** Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh—who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands—that at that time you were without Messiah, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. 13But now in Messiah Yeshua you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Messiah. 19Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, 20having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Yeshua Messiah Himself being the chief cornerstone, 21in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, 22in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

***3 John 1:9** I wrote to the church, but Diotrephes, who loves to have the preeminence among them, does not receive us.

***Matthew 5:18** For I tell you truly, until heaven and earth pass away, not a single jot, not a stroke of a pen, will disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished.

***John 10:31-33** The Jews had again brought some rocks to stone Yeshua to death. Yeshua replied to them, I've shown you many good things that come from the Father. For which of these good things do you want to stone me to death? ³³ The Jews answered Yeshua, We're going to stone you to death, not for any good things you've done, but for dishonoring God. You claim to be God, although you're only a man.

***Jeremiah 16:19** "O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come unto thee from the ends of the earth, and shall say, Surely our fathers have inherited lies, vanity, and things wherein there is no profit.

***John 1:10-11** He was in the world, and though the world was made through Him, the world did not know Him. 11He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. 12But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: 13who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

***Numbers 21:6-9** Then the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people, so that many people of Israel died. So the people came to Moses and said, We have sinned, because we have spoken against the LORD and against you; intercede with the LORD, that He will remove the serpents from us. And Moses interceded for the people. Then the LORD said to Moses, Make a fiery serpent, and put it on a flag pole; and it shall come about, that everyone who is bitten, and looks at it, will live. So Moses made a bronze serpent and put it on the flag pole; and it came about, that if a serpent bit someone, and he looked at the bronze serpent, he lived.

***John 3:13-15** No one has ascended into heaven except the One who descended from heaven—the Son of Man. Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes in Him may have eternal life...

***Isaiah 45:23** ... so that at the name of Yeshua every knee shall bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and that every tongue will confess and openly acknowledge that Yeshua Messiah is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

***Leviticus 13:46** He shall remain unclean all the days during which he has the infection; he is unclean. He shall live alone; his dwelling shall be outside the camp.

***Isaiah 53:3** He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, acquainted with grief. Like one from whom men hide their faces, He was despised, and we esteemed Him not.

***Hebrews 12:12-13** Therefore Yeshua also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate. Therefore, let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His reproach.

***Isaiah 53:4** Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

***I John 2:2** He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

***2 Corinthians 5:21** For our sake He made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.

***Genesis 3:15** And I will put enmity between your seed and the seed of the woman. He shall bruise your head and you shall bruise His heel.

Genesis 2:10-14 A river flowed out of Eden to water the garden, and there it divided and became four rivers.

***Psalm 80:13-14** A boar (or pig) from the forest devours it And whatever moves in the field feeds on it. Return, O God of Hosts, we pray! Look down from heaven and see! Attend to this vine—...

***Genesis 3:15** And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed. He will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.

***Daniel 7:2-3** Daniel said: In my vision at night I looked, and there before me were the four winds of heaven churning up the great sea. Four great beasts, each different from the others, came up out of the sea.

(4) **1st like a lion** - the mind of a human was given to it. (5) **2nd like a BEAR** - told to eat its fill of flesh (6) **3rd like a leopard** - with 4 heads - given authority to rule -

***Daniel 7:13** In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven.

***Daniel 7:18** But the holy people of the Most High will receive the kingdom and will possess it forever—yes, for ever and ever.'

***Daniel 7:26** But the court will sit, and his power will be taken away and completely destroyed forever. Then the sovereignty, power and greatness of all the kingdoms under heaven will be handed over to the holy people of the Most High.

***Leviticus 14:2-3** This shall be the law of the leper for the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought to the priest And the priest shall go out of the camp, and the priest shall examine him.....

***I Peter 2:9** But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, to proclaim the virtues of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

***Obadiah 1:21** Then saviors shall come to Mount Zion to judge the mountains of Esau and the kingdom shall be the LORD'S.

***Psalm 121** I will lift up my eyes to the hills—From whence comes my help?
My help comes from the LORD, Who made heaven and earth. He will not allow your foot to be moved; He who keeps you will not slumber. Behold, He who keeps Israel
Shall neither slumber nor sleep. The LORD is your keeper; The LORD is your shade at your right hand. The sun shall not strike you by day, Nor the moon by night
The LORD shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul. The LORD shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore.
