Does Lebanon Prove We Are At The End and Messiah Is Coming!

6.27.26; 12 Tammuz, 5786

Num. 19:1-25;9; Mic. 5:6-6:8; Matt. 21:1-11

***Numbers 19:1-2** And the LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying,² This is the ordinance (chuchat) of the law which the LORD has commanded, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, that **they bring You a red heifer without spot, wherein is no blemish, and upon which has never been a yoke:**³ And you shall give her to Eleazar the priest, that **he may bring her forth outside the camp,** and one shall slay her before his face:

***Hebrews 10:18-20** And where these have been forgiven, **an offering for sin is no longer needed.** ¹⁹Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Yeshua ²⁰by the new and living way opened for us through the curtain of His body,...

***Joshua 2:17-18** The men said to her, "We will not be bound by this oath you made us swear ¹⁸unless, when we enter the lad, **you have tied this scarlet cord** in the window through which you let us down, and unless you have brought your father and mother and brother and all your family into your house.

***Exodus 12:22** Take a bunch of hyssop, dip it into the blood in the basin and put some of the blood on the top and on both sides of the doorframe. None of you shall go out of the door of his house until morning.

***John 19:29-30** A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, **put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant,** and lifted it to Yeshua's lips. ³⁰When he had received the sour wine, Yeshua said, It is finished. With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

***Ezekiel 36:25** I will **sprinkle clean water on you,** and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you..

***I Corinthians 6:14** And **God raised the Lord** and will also raise us up by his power.

***Isaiah 26:19** **Your dead shall live; their bodies shall rise.** You who dwell in the dust, awake and sing for joy!

***I Thessalonians 4:16** For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Messiah will rise first.

***Ezekiel 36:24-25** For I will take you from among the nations and gather you out of all countries, and I will bring you back into your own land. Then **I will sprinkle clean water on you**, and you shall be clean; **I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols**.

***Isaiah 2:3** And many peoples will come and say, Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths. The law will go out from Zion, the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

***Micah 4:2** He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths.

***Numbers 20:22-29** The whole Israelite community set out from Kadesh and came to Mount Hor. ²³ At Mount Hor, near the border of Edom, the LORD said to Moses and Aaron, ²⁴ "Aaron will be gathered to his people. He will not enter the land I give the Israelites, because both of you rebelled against my command at the waters of Meribah. ²⁵ Get Aaron and his son Eleazar and take them up Mount Hor. ²⁶ Remove Aaron's garments and put them on his son Eleazar, for Aaron will be gathered to his people; he will die there. ²⁷ Moses did as the LORD commanded: They went up Mount Hor in the sight of the whole community. ²⁸ Moses removed Aaron's garments and put them on his son Eleazar. And Aaron died there on top of the mountain. Then Moses and Eleazar came down from the mountain, ²⁹ and when the whole community learned that Aaron had died, all the Israelites mourned for him thirty days.

***Deuteronomy 34:5** And Moses the servant of the Lord died there in Moab, as the Lord had said.

***Numbers 20:1** Then the sons of Israel, the whole congregation, came to the wilderness of Zin in the first month; and the people stayed at Kadesh. Now Miriam died there and was buried there. there in Moab, as the Lord had said.

***Numbers 20:1-13 (SELECTIONS)** Then the children of Israel, the whole congregation, came into the Wilderness of Zin in the first month, and the people stayed in Kadesh; and Miriam died there and was buried there. ² Now there was no water for the congregation; so they gathered together against Moses and Aaron. ³ And the people contended with Moses and spoke, saying: "If only we had died when our brethren died before the LORD! ⁴ Why have you brought up the assembly of the LORD into this wilderness, that we and our animals should die here? ⁵ And why have you made us come up out of Egypt, to bring us to this evil place? It is not a place of grain or figs or vines or

pomegranates; nor is there any water to drink." ⁶ So Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly to the door of the tabernacle of meeting, and they fell on their faces. And the glory of the LORD appeared to them. ⁷ Then **the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,** ⁸ **"Take the rod; you and your brother Aaron gather the congregation together. Speak to the rock** before their eyes, and it will yield its water; thus you shall bring **water for them out of the rock,** and give drink to the congregation and their animals." ⁹ So Moses took the rod from before the LORD as He commanded him. ¹⁰ And Moses and Aaron gathered the assembly together before the rock; and he said to them, **"Hear now, you rebels!** Must we bring water for you out of this rock?" ¹¹ Then **Moses lifted his hand and struck the rock twice with his rod;** and water came out abundantly, and the congregation and their animals drank. ¹² **Then the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron,** **"Because you did not believe Me,** to hallow Me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore you shall not bring this assembly into the land which I have given them." ¹³ This was the water of Meribah, because the children of Israel contended with the LORD, and He was hallowed among them.

***John 4:14** But whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, **the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life.**

***Exodus 17:5-6** And the LORD said to Moses, "Walk on ahead of the people and take some of the elders of Israel with you. Take along in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go. **6** Behold, I will stand there before you by the rock at Horeb, and **when you strike the rock, water will come out of it for the people to drink.** So Moses did this in the sight of the elders of Israel.

***Numbers 20:7-8** Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, **8** "Take the rod; you and your brother Aaron gather the congregation together. **Speak to the rock** before their eyes, and it will yield its water; thus you shall bring water for them out of the rock, and give drink to the congregation and their animals.

***Numbers 22:12** But God said to Balaam, Do not go with them. **You are not to curse this people, for they are blessed.**

***Jeremiah 1:13-14** **13** And the word of the LORD came to me the second time, saying, What do you see? And I said, **I see a boiling pot, and it is facing away from the north.** **14** Then the LORD said to me: **Out of the north calamity shall break forth on all the inhabitants of the land.**

***Ezekiel 28:21** **Son of man, set your face** toward Sidon, and prophesy against her.

***Joel 3:4** Now what do you have against Me, O Tyre, Sidon, and all the regions of Philistia? Are you rendering against Me a recompense? If you retaliate against Me, I will swiftly and speedily return your recompense upon your heads.

***Isaiah 26:19-21** Your dead shall live; Together with my dead body they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; For your dew is like the dew of herbs, And the earth shall cast out the dead.

20 Come, my people, enter your chambers, And shut your doors behind you; Hide yourself, as it were, for a little moment, Until the indignation is past.

21 For, behold, the LORD cometh out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity: the earth also shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain.

***Jeremiah 1:13-14** **13** And the word of the Lord came to me the second time, saying, What do you see? And I said, I see a boiling pot, and it is facing away from the north."
14 Then the LORD said to me: Out of the north calamity shall break forth on all the inhabitants of the land.

***Ezekiel 28:24** And there shall no longer be a pricking brier or a painful thorn for the house of Israel from among all who are around them, who despise them. Then they shall know that I am the Lord God.
