Moses' Words Tell Us We Are the Last Generation!
July 18, 2026; Av 4 5786
Deut. 1:1-3:22; Isa. 1:1-27; Matt. 24:1-22

***Deuteronomy 1:1** These are the words which Moses spoke to all Israel on this side of the Jordan in the wilderness, in the plain opposite Suph, between Paran, Tophel, Laban, Hazereth and Dizahab;

***Deuteronomy 1:2** It is eleven days' journey from Horeb by the way of Mount Seir to Kadesh-barnea

***Deuteronomy 1:12** How [eicha] can I bear alone the trouble of you, and the burden, and the bickering!

***Ecclesiastes 1:9** What has been will be again, what has been done will be done again; there is nothing new under the sun.

***Deuteronomy 1:3** In the fortieth year, on the first day of the eleventh month, Moses spoke to the people of Israel according to all that the LORD had given him in commandment to them,

***Deuteronomy 1:4** After he had defeated Sihon the king of the Amorites, who lived in Heshbon, and Og the king of Bashan, who lived in Ashtaroth and in Edrei.

***Deuteronomy 2:32-34** Then Sihon came out against us, he and all his people, to battle at Jahaz. 33 And the LORD our God gave him over to us, and we defeated him and his sons and all his people. 34 And we captured all his cities at that time and devoted to destruction every city, men, women, and children. We left no survivors.

***Deuteronomy 3:4b-6** There was not a city that we did not take from them—sixty cities, the whole region of Argob, the kingdom of Og in Bashan. 5 All these were cities fortified with high walls, gates, and bars, besides very many unwalled villages. 6 And we devoted them to destruction, as we did to Sihon the king of Heshbon, devoting to destruction every city, men, women, and children.

***Deuteronomy 3:2** But the LORD said to me, Do not fear him, for I have given him and all his people and his land into your hand. And you shall do to him as you did to Sihon the king of the Amorites, who lived at Heshbon.

***Luke 6:45** A good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and an evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart. For **the mouth speaks what the heart is full of.**

***Matthew 7:28-29:** When Yeshua had finished saying these things, the crowds were astonished at his teaching, because he taught as one who had authority, and not as their teachers of the law.

***Mark 1:22:** The people were amazed at his teaching, because he taught them as one who had authority, not as the teachers of the law.

****John 7:46** Never has anyone spoken like this man! the officers answered.

***John 7:15:** The **Jews there were amazed** and asked, How did this man get such learning without having been taught?

***John 7:16-17** My teaching is not My own, Yeshua replied. It comes from Him who sent Me. / If anyone desires to do His will, he will know whether My teaching is from God or whether I speak on My own.

***Isaiah 50:4** The Lord GOD has given Me the tongue of the learned, That I should know how to speak A word in season to him who is weary. He awakens Me morning by morning, He awakens My ear To hear as the learned.

***Matthew 22:35-36** One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: ³⁶ Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?

***Matthew 22:37-40:** Yeshua states, Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself. All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.

***Mark 12:32** So the scribe said to Him, Well said, Teacher. You have spoken the truth, for there is one God, and there is no other but He.

***James 2:14-17** What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him? ¹⁵ If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food, ¹⁶ and one of you says to them, Depart in peace, be warmed and filled, but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit? ¹⁷ Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

***Deuteronomy 4:30** When you are in distress, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, when you turn to the Lord your God and obey His voice.

***Deuteronomy 1:8** See, I have set the land before you; go in and possess the land which the LORD swore to your fathers—to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob—to give to them and their descendants after them.

***Jeremiah 30:3:** For behold, the days are coming,' says the LORD, 'that I will bring back from captivity My people Israel and Judah,' says the LORD. 'And I will cause them to return to the land that I gave to their fathers, and they shall possess it.

***Ezekiel 36:24:** For I will take you out of the nations; I will gather you from all the countries and bring you back into your own land.

***Amos 9:14-15** I will bring back the captives of My people Israel; They shall build the waste cities and inhabit them; They shall plant vineyards and drink wine from them; They shall also make gardens and eat fruit from them. I will plant them in their land, and no longer shall they be pulled up From the land I have given them, Says the LORD your God.

***Deuteronomy 1:21, See**, the LORD your God has placed the land before you. Go up and take possession, as the LORD, the God of your fathers, has told you.

***Deuteronomy 1:8** See, I have set before you the land. Go in and possess the land that the LORD swore to your⁺ fathers Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give to them and to their seed after them.

***Isaiah 40:3-5** A voice of one calling: In the wilderness prepare the way for the LORD; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be raised up, every mountain and hill made low; the rough ground shall become level, the rugged places a plain. And the glory of the LORD will be revealed, and all people will see it together. For the mouth of the LORD has spoken.

***Malachi 3:1** Behold, I send My messenger, And he will prepare the way before Me. And the LORD, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple, Even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming, Says the LORD of hosts.

***Isaiah 1:1** The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah, kings of Judah.

***Matthew 24:1-2b** Then Yeshua went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. ² And Yeshua said to them, "Do you not see all these things?

***Matthew 24:2** Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down.

***2 Thessalonians 2:3-4** Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

***Matthew 24:15** Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (whoever reads, let him understand),

***Revelation 11:1-2:** Then I was given a reed like a measuring rod. And the angel stood, saying, "Rise and measure the temple of God, the altar, and those who worship there. But leave out the court which is outside the temple, and do not measure it, for it has been given to the Gentiles. And they will tread the holy city underfoot for forty-two months.

***Deuteronomy 1:6-7a** The LORD our God spoke to us in Horeb, saying: 'You have dwelt long enough at this mountain. Turn and take your journey, and go.....
