Deuteronomy 1:1-3:22; Isaiah 1:1-27; Matthew 24:1-22



***Jeremiah 6:16** Thus saith the Lord, Stand in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where the good way is, and walk therein, and you shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk *therein*.

***Isaiah 8:20** should not a people seek their God? Should they seek the dead on behalf of the living? To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, they have no light of dawn.

***Isaiah 8:16** Bind up the testimony, Seal the law among my disciples.

***Proverbs 6:23** For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light; And reproofs of instruction are the way of life:

***John 5:46-47** For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me; for he wrote about Me. But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe My words?

***John 1:1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us. And we beheld His glory, a glory as of an only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

***Revelation 22:13** I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.

***Exodus 4:10-12a** Then Moses said to the LORD, Please, Lord, I am not a man of words (eloquent, fluent), neither before nor since You have spoken to Your servant; for I am slow of speech and tongue.

*Deuteronomy 1:1a says These are the words that Moses spoke to all of Israel.....

*John 7:19-23 Did not Moses give you the law, yet none of you keeps the law? Why do you seek to kill Me? The people answered and said, You have a demon. Who is seeking to kill You? Jesus answered them, I did one miracle, and you are all amazed. But because Moses gave you circumcision, you circumcise a boy on the Sabbath (not that it is from Moses, but from the patriarchs)... If a man receives circumcision on the Sabbath, so that the law of Moses should not be broken, are you angry with Me because I made a man completely well on the Sabbath?

*Deuteronomy 1:1-2 These are the words that Moses spoke to all of Israel, on the other side of the Jordan, concerning the Wilderness concerning the Arabah opposite the Sea of Reeds, between Paran and between Tophel, and Laban, and Hazeroth, and Di-zahab; *It is eleven days from Horeb by way of Mount Se*

*Exodus 16:1-3 And they took their journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the wilderness of Sin, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after their departing out of the land of Egypt. And the whole congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness: And the children of Israel said unto them, Would to God we had died by the hand of the Lord in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the flesh pots, and when we did eat bread to the full; for you have brought us forth into this wilderness, to kill this whole assembly with hunger. ir until Dadesh-barnea.

*Numbers 36:13 While Israel was staying in Shittim, the men began to indulge in sexual immorality with Moabite women, who invited them to the sacrifices to their gods. The people ate the sacrificial meal and bowed down before these gods. So Israel yoked themselves to the Baal of Peor. And the LORD's anger burned against them. And between Paran and Tophel.

*Numbers. 13:32-33 &14:2-4 **So they began to spread lies among the Israelites about the land they had explored.** They said, The land we explored is one that devours those who live there. All the people we saw there are very tall. We saw Nephilim there. (The descendants of Anak are Nephilim.) We felt as small as grasshoppers, and that's how we must have looked to them. Then all the people in the Israelite community raised their voices and cried out loud all that

night. They complained to Moses and Aaron, "If only we had died in Egypt or this desert! Why is the Lord bringing us to this land—just to have us die in battle? Our wives and children will be taken as prisoners of war! **Wouldn't it be better for us to go back to Egypt? They said to each other, Let's choose a leader and go back to Egypt.**

***Exodus 32:2-4** Aaron answered them, Take off the gold earrings that your wives, your sons and your daughters are wearing, and bring them to me. So all the people took off their earrings and brought them to Aaron. **He took what they handed him and made it into an idol cast in the shape of a calf**, fashioning it with a tool. **Then they said, These are your gods, Israel, who brought you up out of Egypt.**

***Exodus 32:19** As he drew near the camp, he saw the calf and the dancing. Then **Moses' anger burned**, and he threw the tablets down and broke them on the base of the mountain.

***Deuteronomy 1:6** The LORD our God spoke to us in Horeb, saying: **You have dwelt long enough at this mountain.**

***Deuteronomy 1:7** Turn and take your journey, and go to the mountains of the Amorites, to all the neighboring places in the plain, in the mountains and in the lowland, in the South and on the seacoast, to the land of the Canaanites and to Lebanon, as far as the great river, the River Euphrates.

***Genesis 12:1** The Lord had said to Abram, Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you. I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you and curse those who curse you. **All the families of the earth will find blessing in you.**

***Deuteronomy 1:8** See, I have set the land before you: **go in and possess the land** which the LORD **swore to give to your fathers** - to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob - to give to them **and their descendants after them.**

***Matthew 23:37-39** O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children

together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing! See! Your house is left to you desolate for I say to you, You shall see Me no more till you say, Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!

***Deuteronomy 1:8** says: to them לָהֶם referring to the 1st redemption OF the children of Israel from Egypt then וּלְזָרָעָם to the generations after them who would return from the 2nd galut in Babylon; and finally to - אַחֲרֵיהֶם:

***Matthew 3:1-3** In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, and saying, Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand! For this is he who was spoken of by the prophet Isaiah, saying: The voice of one crying in the wilderness: Prepare the way of the LORD; make His paths straight.

***Psalm 10:16a** ...the Lord is King forever and ever.....

***Psalm 145:13a** Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, 145:13

***Daniel 4:3b** His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and His dominion is from generation to generation.

***Matthew 19:23** Then Yeshua said to His disciples, "Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven. And again I say to you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.

***Isaiah 66:1** This is what the LORD says: Heaven is My throne, and earth is My footstool. What kind of house will you build for Me?

***Luke 17:21** Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.

***Matthew 28:18-20** And Yeshua came and spoke to them saying, All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

***Matthew 6:10** Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth..."

***Mark 12:28** Then one of the scribes came and having heard them reasoning together, perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him, Which is the first commandment of all? Yeshua answered him, The first of all the commandments is: Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all you mind and with all your strength. This is the first commandment. And the second, is this: you shall love your neighbor as yourself. There is no commandment greater than these.

***Deuteronomy 6:6** And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart.....

((***Deuteronomy 6:9** which tells us the commandments are to be taught to our children, spoken of at all times during the day and written on our doorposts.))

***Isaiah 40:3** Listen! It's the voice of someone shouting, Clear the way through the wilderness for the LORD! Make a straight highway through the wasteland for our God!

***Isaiah 61:2** He has sent me to tell those who mourn that the time of the LORD's favor has come, and with it, the day of God's anger against their enemies.

***Isaiah 40:1** Comfort, O comfort My people," says your God.

***II Peter 3:10-11** But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God,
